- 5. Submit application


#### 1. Registration

Under Portal Access, select Scholarship Applicant.


After filling out the information and accepting the terms and conditions click **register**. You will receive an email confirming successful registration with our site.

APABA will award 10 scholarships in the amount of \$500 to recent graduates (class of 2019 or 2020) who meet the following criteria and

Finalists may be interviewed by one or more members of the APABA Scholarship Committee.

Scholarship applicants will be notified of decisions by email in September 2020.

#### Founded in 1998, the Asian Pacific American Bar Association of Los Angeles County (APABA) adopted the following multifaceted mission:

- 1, to establish a broad base of membership that is reflective of the ethnic and cultural diversity of the Asian Pacific Islander American (APIA) community in the greater Los Angeles Area;
- 2. to provide a vehicle and forum for the unified expression of opinions and positions by the Association upon current social, political, economic, legal or other matters or events of concern to the members;
- 3, to foster the exchange of ideas and information amongst and between Association members and other members of the legal profession, the judiciary and the community;
- 4. to encourage and promote the professional growth of the members;
- 5. to provide an opportunity for fellowship among the Association's members;
- 6. to develop and encourage inter-cooperation with and between other bar organizations, especially other minority bar
- 7, to provide coordinated service to the community-at-large as well as to the local APIA community.

#### Candidates must:

- Be a U.S. Citizen (due to IRS restrictions).
- (recent graduates may register as a law student member for free until after they pass the bar).
- Demonstrate leadership potential, maturity, and responsibility, as well as past or current commitment to public service and social justice, with an emphasis on contributions to the Asian Pacific American community.
- Provide documentation of law school completion/graduation in 2020.
- Provide documentation of registration for the October 2020 California Bar Exam.
- Intend to practice law in California after taking the California Bar Exam.
- Be a member of APABA (class of 2020 graduates may register as a law student member for free until after they pass the bar).

\*Priority will be given to candidates who intend to work in a nonprofit organization or in government, particularly those serving the APA community in Los Angeles County.
